**Gunner 14755 Thomas George BOUGHTON MM, "D" Battery, 95<sup>th</sup> Brigade, Royal Field Artillery (R.F.A).** Died 27<sup>th</sup> September 1917. Born Lyminge. Enlisted Dover.

BRADLEY F

**Private 76898 Frederick Charles BRADLEY, 11<sup>th</sup> Battalion, Durham Light Infantry. Formerly (3072) Royal Engineers.** Died 30<sup>th</sup> November 1917 aged 32 years. Enlisted Gillingham, Resided Lyminge,

BUSHELL .C

**Private G/1443 Henry Cecil BUSHELL, 8<sup>th</sup> Battalion, The Buffs (East Kent Regiment).** Died 3<sup>rd</sup> September 1916. Born Elham, Enlisted Lyminge, Resided Lyminge.

**Driver 731722 Langhorne R, Royal Field Artillery. Formerly Private (2037) Welsh Regiment.**

**Rifleman A/204870 Henry LINTOTT. 11<sup>th</sup> Battalion Kings Royal Rifle Corps.** Died 24<sup>th</sup> March 1918. Born Harbledown. Enlisted Canterbury. Resided Folkestone.

**Corporal 14754 John Charles LOTT. "C" Battery., 73 Brigade, Royal Field Artillery (R.F.A).** Died 5<sup>th</sup> April 1917. Born Lyminge. Enlisted Dover.

MORGAN H

**Sapper Henry MORGAN. Royal Engineers (R.E) – NO TRACE**

**Lance Corporal S/349 Henry James OVENDEN, 2<sup>nd</sup> Battalion, The Buffs (East Kent Regiment).** Died 25<sup>th</sup> May 1915. Born Ashford. Enlisted Folkestone. Resided Lyminge.

POTTEN F.G

**Gunner 76312 Frederick George POTTEN. Royal Garrison Artillery.** Died 25<sup>th</sup> November 1917. Born Chilham. Enlisted Dover. Resided Lyminge.

**Sergeant 280539 George SKEER. MM, Croix de Guerre (Belgium), 222<sup>nd</sup> Siege Battery Royal Garrison Artillery.** Died 21<sup>st</sup> March 1918 aged 33 years. Born Harbledown. Enlisted Ashford.

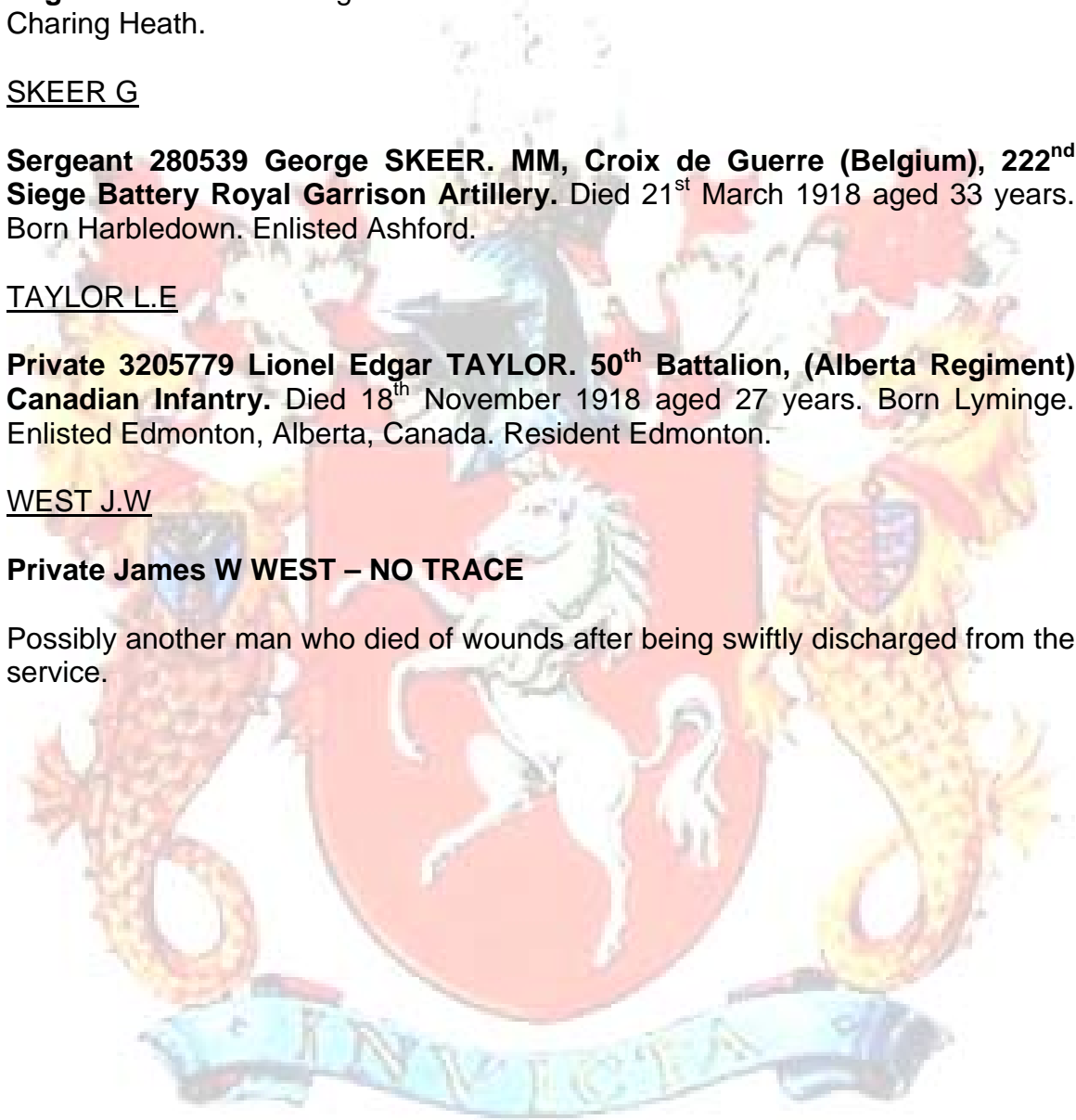
TAYLOR L.E

**Bombardier 894179 Ernest Edward HAYESMORE. 114<sup>th</sup> Field Regiment, Royal Artillery (R.A).** Died 21<sup>st</sup> April 1944 aged 28 years.

MERCER R.A

**Corporal 6399330 Reginald Albert MERCER. 1<sup>st</sup> Parachute Squadron, Royal Engineers.** Died 24<sup>th</sup> November 1942 aged 22 years.

OVENDEN F.G
