RONALD J.M

**Captain James McBain RONALD. 2<sup>nd</sup> Battalion, The Buffs (East Kent Regiment).** Died 23<sup>rd</sup> April 1915 aged 39 years.

MARQUIS CONYNGHAM

**Lieutenant The 5<sup>th</sup> Marquis of Conyngham. 7<sup>th</sup> (South Irish Horse) Battalion, Royal Irish Regiment (R.I.R).** Died 9<sup>th</sup> November 1918 (only 2 days before the war ended).

ALEXANDER D

**Company Sergeant Major (CSM) L/8907 David ALEXANDER MM. 6<sup>th</sup> Battalion, The Buffs (East Kent Regiment).** Died 29<sup>th</sup> September 1918. Born London. Enlisted Canterbury. Resided Patixbourne.

Awarded the Military Medal (MM).

BRICKENDEN F.S

**Sapper 63140 Frederick Charles BRICKENDEN. 88<sup>th</sup> Field Company, Royal Engineers (RE).** Died Gallipoli, Turkey 30<sup>th</sup> October 1915. Born Elham. Enlisted Canterbury.

STEVENS C.H

**Private 54003 Charles Henry STEVENS. 2<sup>nd</sup> Battalion, King's Royal Rifle Corps (K.R.R.C). Formerly (2543) Royal Army Medical Corps (RAMC). Formerly (T4/238984) Army Service Corps (ASC).** Died 25<sup>th</sup> September 1918 or 1915. Born Sandwich. Enlisted Canterbury. Resided Sevenoaks.

Soldiers Died gives his date of death as 1915 whereas CWGC gives 1918.

STEVENS A.E

**Private D/11037 Albert Edward STEVENS. 3<sup>rd</sup> Dragoon Guards (Prince of Wales Own).** Died 30<sup>th</sup> May 1917. Born Patixbourne. Enlisted Canterbury. Resided Patixbourne.
